

2024 in Review

Impact in Worcester County

- 5,110 hours of in-person, community-based recreation programming
- 480 children supported with gifts through the Holiday Giving Tree
- 225,000 hours of community and volunteer activities were provided to CBDES this year
- 160% increase in individuals on the autism spectrum receiving supports through the ASD Pre-Engagement Coaching program



- 94% of guardians and families expressed satisfaction with the services provided by The Arc.
- 95% of individuals served expressed satisfaction with the services provided by The Arc.
- 92% of staff reported satisfaction with the sense of purpose and fulfillment in their work

- 241% increase in community participation in Day Habilitation
- 1838 hours invested in legislative and self-advocacy skill building
- 100% of individuals actively participating in employment services are making at least minimum wage or higher.
- 860 hours invested in providing financial literacy support to individuals



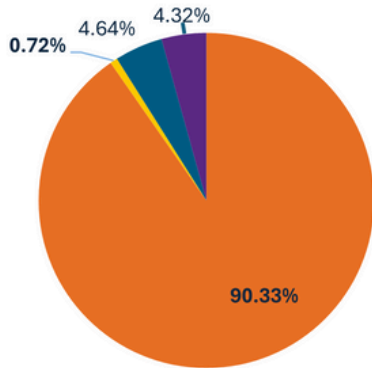
- 99% DDS Licensing score and 100% Certification score achieved by the CBDES Division .

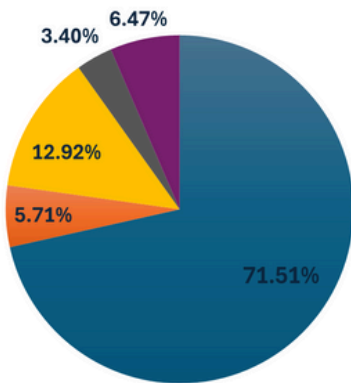
